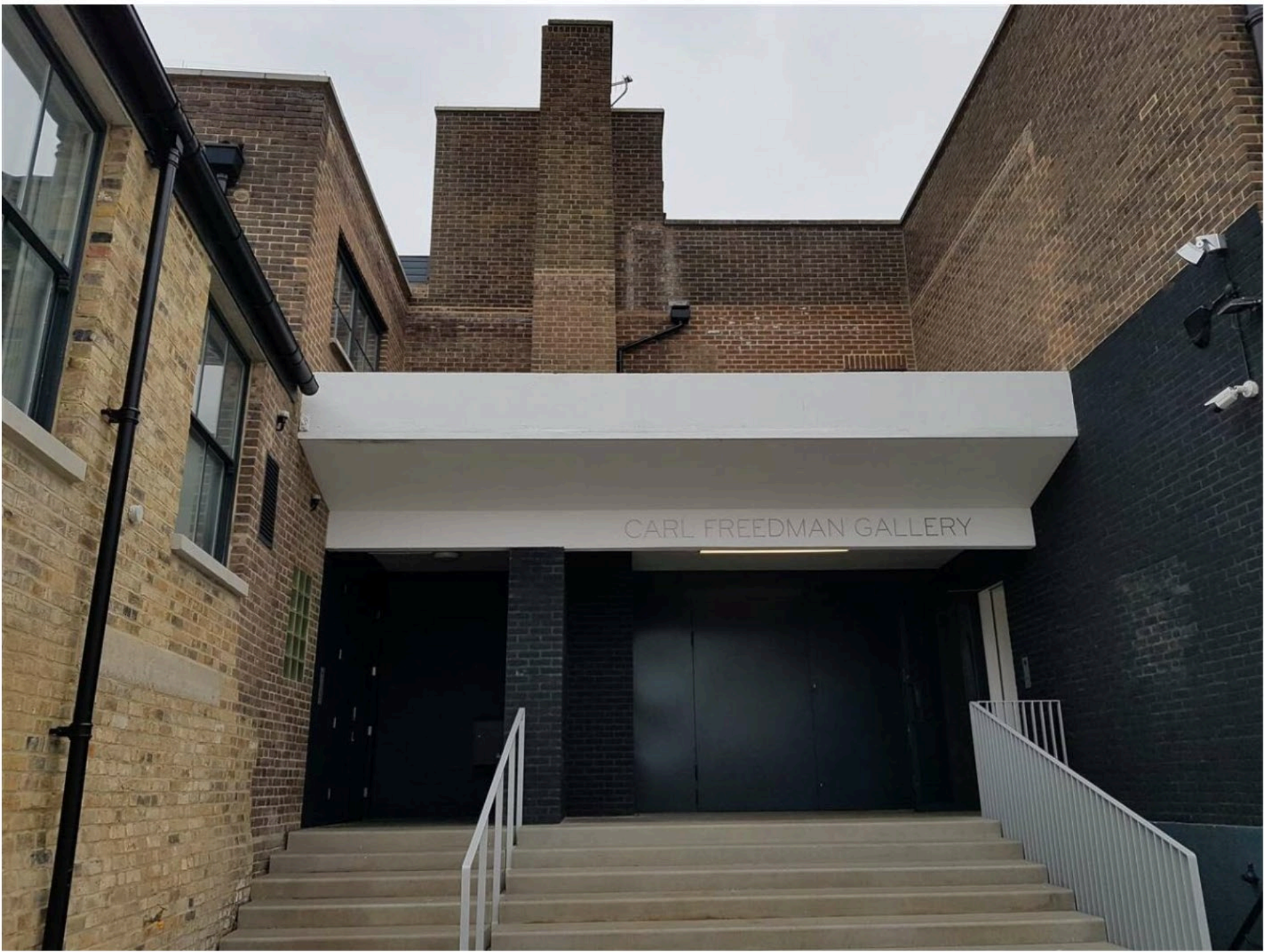


FRIEZE 2023: TOP 10 MUST-SEE BOOTHS
